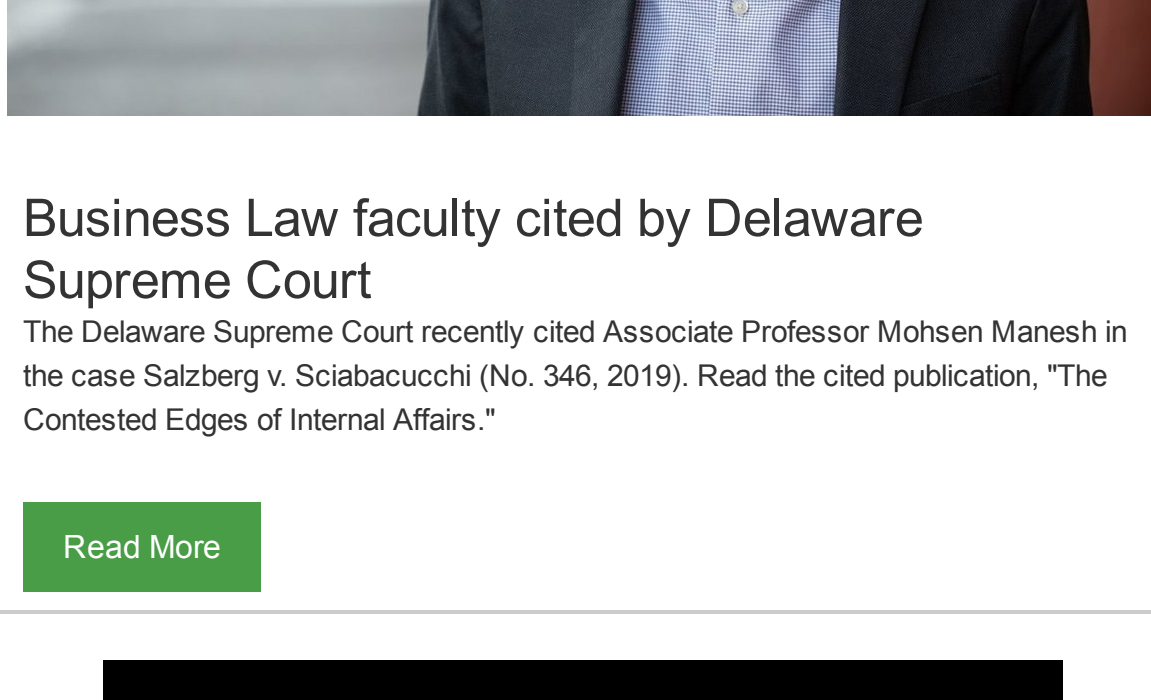


Summer Sports Law Institute pivots to remote instruction

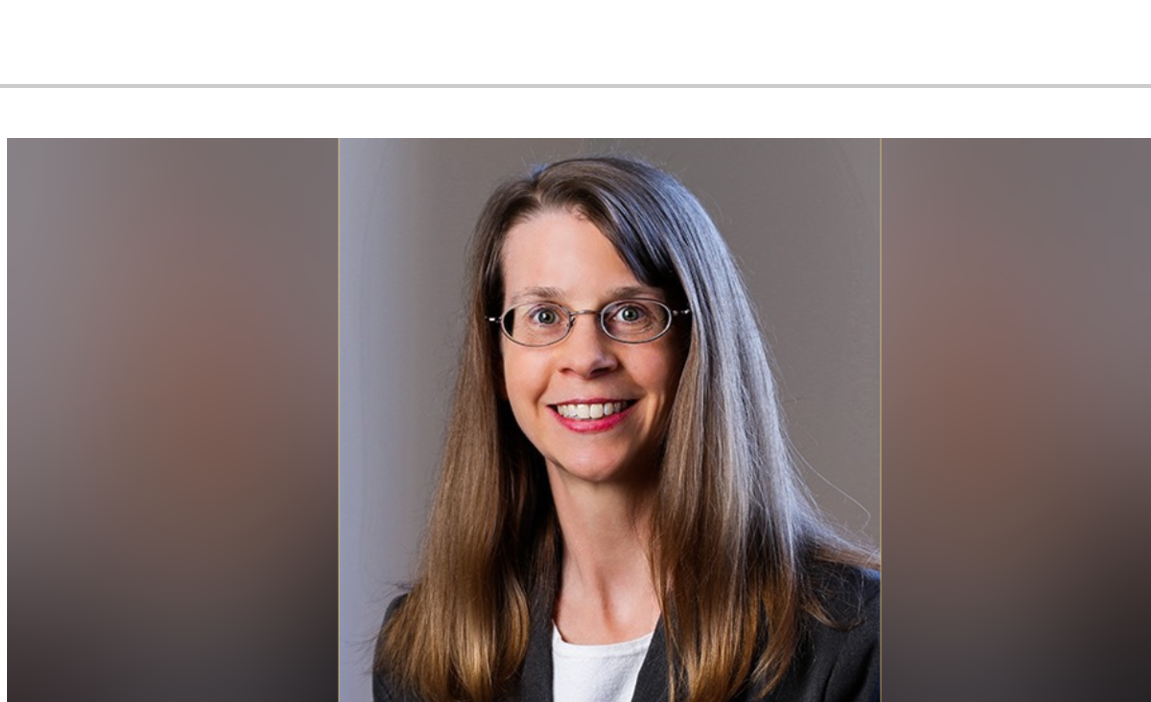

Business Law faculty cited by Delaware Supreme Court

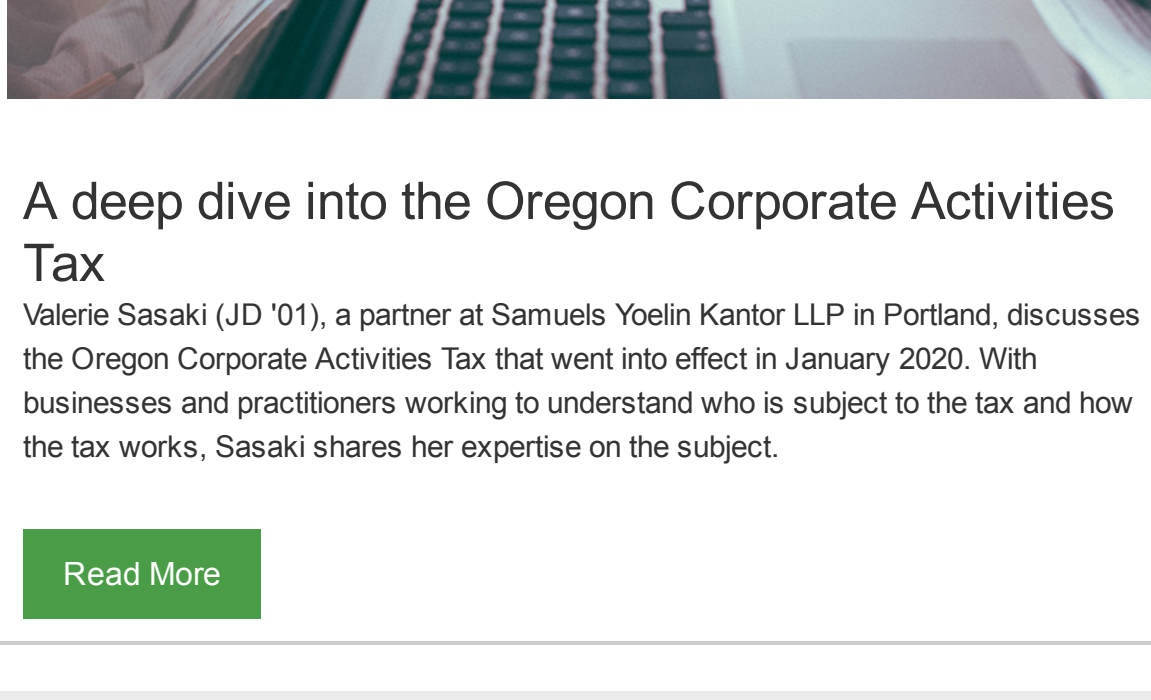

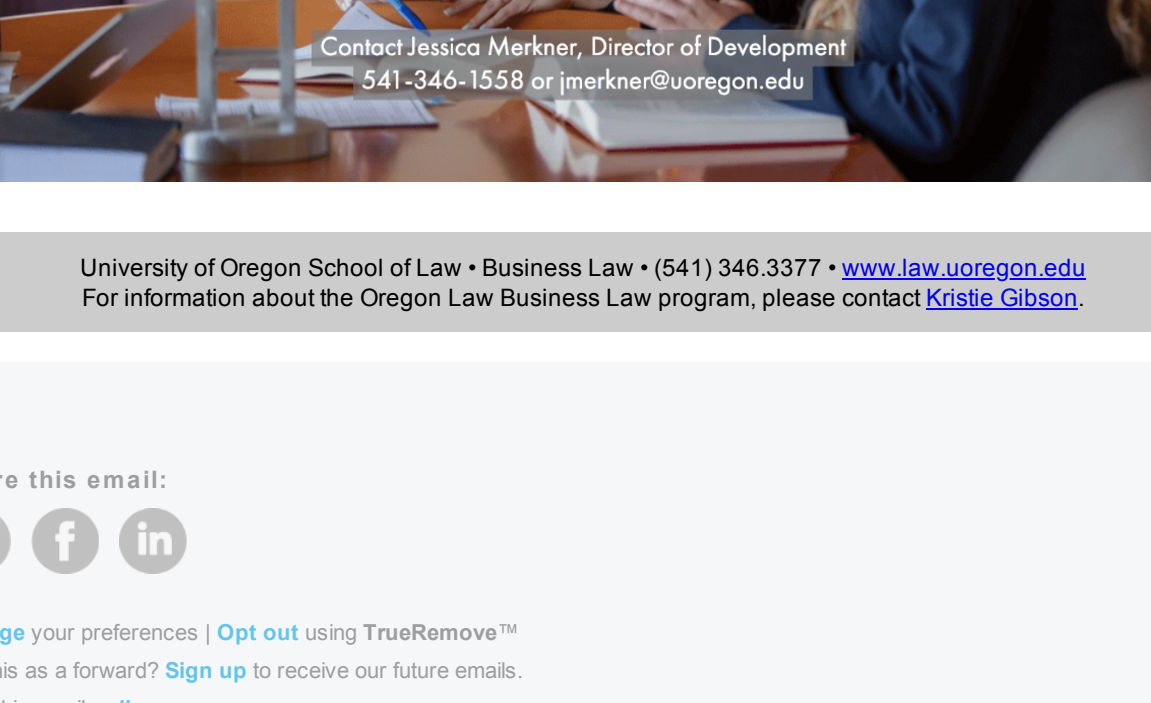


Oregon Women Lawyers Foundation taps Business Law faculty as newest president

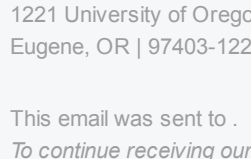
